

OF HOMOEOPATHY IN TONSILLITIS OF

THE IMPACT OF HOMOEOPATHY IN TONSILLITIS OF PEDIATRIC AGE GROUP: A CASE SERIES

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Abstract:

Background: Acute infections of the upper respiratory tract contribute to over 20% of the morbidity of the population, with the highest incidence in children. Among upper respiratory infections, Tonsillitis is one of the commonest problem in the children that are seen in the daily practice. The role of homoeopathy is very vital in treating such cases. In this article I am sharing 5 cases successfully treated with individualized homoeopathic medicine.

Methods: A detailed case series analysis of 5 cases was conducted on children suffering with chronic tonsillitis from 1-12 years age group. Each case underwent thorough case taking following pediatric case taking Performa in OPD. And after proper analysis and evaluation of symptoms and repertorization an individualized homoeopathic medicine was prescribed in each case using centisimal scale.

Results: all the 5 patients showed marked improvement after giving homoeopathic medicine. No patients reported any adverse effects

Conclusion: This article confirms the potential benefits of homeopathic interventions in tonsillitis of pediatric age group.

Introduction: Tonsils are composed of tissue that is similar to the lymph nodes or glands found in the neck, groin, and other places in the body. They are part of ring of glandular tissue encircling the back of the throat. Inflammation of the tonsils is called as tonsillitis. There are of two types mainly-Acute and chronic. Chronic tonsillitis may be a complication of acute tonsillitis. This may be due to incomplete resolution of acute infection.

In modern medicines there are harsh treatments but in homoeopathy we have gentle treatment which helps in curing such cases. This article delves into a case series examining the outcomes of homoeopathic treatment in tonsillitis of children.

Case series:

Case No. 1:

YM a 10 year's male, came in my OPD on 11/3/24, with the complaints of pain, redness in throat and recurrent tonsillitis < cold air, cold food, winter with pain in throat and fever. Duration of the illness was 2 years. Mental symptoms were irritability, ailments after anger. Physical generals were less thirst, desire for salt & smoked meat, dirty tongue, and chilly patient. Calcarea phosphoricum 200 was prescribed and then further follow ups were done. After assessment of outcome marked improvement (Grade-I) was found.

SK a 12 year's girl, came in my opd on 05/04/24, with the complaints of pain in throat with enlarged tonsils, and dysphagia <change of weather. Duration of the illness was 4 yrs. Mental symptom was irritability, frightened easily. Physical generals were lack of appetite, good thirst, desire for salt, egg, profuse sweat and hot patient. Calcarea carb 200 was prescribed and then further follow ups were done. After assessment of outcome moderate improvement (Grade-II) was found.

JG a 5 year's boy, came to my opd on 18/4/24, with the complaints of tonsillitis with fever and sore pain in throat < cold, eating, night and Post auricular lymph node was swelling. Duration of the illness was 1 yrs. Mental symptoms were anger, stubborn. Physical generals were desire for sweet; egg, thirst good, profuse sweat; loose stool, yellowish urine and hot patient. Merc sol 200 was prescribed and then further follow ups were done. After assessment of outcome marked improvement (Grade-II) was found.

AS a 6 year's girl, came on 20/03/24, with the complaints of recurrent swelling of tonsils, redness, splinter like pain < cold, damp weather. duration of the complaints were 2 yrs. Mental symptoms were irritability, headsrong, sensitive. Physical generals were loss of appetite, less thirst, desire for sour. stool – loose, 2-3 times a day, sour sweat and chilly patient. Hepar sulph 200 was prescribed and then further follow ups were done. After assessment of outcome marked improvement (Grade-I) was found.

US a 4 year's girl, came to my opd on 19/4/24, with the complaints of tonsillitis with pain, swelling, in throat with dyspahgia. < drinking, warm liquids, during sleep > drinking cold. Duration of the illness was 9 months. o/e slight purplish appearance in tonsils. Mental symptoms were talkative, loquacious,. Physical generals were moderate thirst, desire for salty, profuse sweat. Offensive, hard stool with pain, frequent micturation and hot patient. Lachesis 200 was prescribed and then further follow ups were done.
